MEMBERSHIP REGULATIONS (EXTRACTS)

- 18.1** Any person aged fourteen years or more may be admitted to membership of the Society.
- 18.2** Membership of the Society shall consist of the following classifications:
- 18.2.1** Junior Membership; and
- 18.2.2** Adult Membership.
- 18.3** Adult Membership shall consist of the following grades:
- 18.3.1** Associate Member
- 18.3.2** Qualified Member
- 18.5 Junior Membership**
- 18.5.1** A Junior member will be aged not less than fourteen (14) years and not more than seventeen (17) years.
- 18.5.3** A Junior Member may not vote at any Ordinary Meeting, General Meeting or Annual General Meeting, except where the Junior Member has completed, in any financial year, the minimum number of hours* of voluntary work set out in separate regulations, then such Junior Member shall be deemed to be a Qualified Member and be accorded all rights and privileges of that grade of membership.
- 18.5.4** A Junior Member shall not be eligible to be elected to Council.
- 18.5.5** A Junior member shall be eligible to be elected or appointed to authorised Committees of the Society
- 18.6 Adult Membership**
- 18.6.1 Associate Membership**
- 18.6.1.2** An Associate Member may not vote at any Ordinary Meeting, Special General Meeting or Annual General Meeting.
- 18.6.1.3** An Associate Member shall not be eligible to be elected to Council.
- 18.6.1.4** An Associate Member shall be eligible to be elected or appointed to an authorised committee of the Society.
- 18.6.1.5** An Associate Member may advance to the grade of Qualified Member upon completing, in any financial year, the minimum number of hours* of voluntary work set out in separate regulations.
- 18.6.2 Qualified Membership**
- 18.6.2.1** A Qualified Member is one who has completed, in any financial year, the minimum number of hours* of voluntary work set out in separate regulations.
- 18.6.2.3** A Qualified Member may vote at any Ordinary Meeting, Special General Meeting or Annual General Meeting.
- 18.6.2.4** A Qualified Member shall be eligible to be elected to Council or appointed to authorised Committees of the Society.
- *Note:** The required minimum number of hours is currently 40.

AUTHORISED WORK PROGRAMMES

The following work programmes are authorised, with hours worked to be recorded in the society's attendance register:

- (a) Restoration of vehicles, equipment, artifacts, etc;
- (b) Construction of track, overhead wire, buildings, etc;
- (c) Maintenance of vehicles, track, equipment, buildings, etc;
- (d) Tramway operations, including driving, fare collection, sales and supervision for which the member is rostered; and
- (e) At the discretion of Council for:
 - (i) Promotion, publicity, etc; and
 - (ii) Location and acquisition of approved equipment.
